Llwybrau Cenedlaethol




National Trails

Parc Cenedlaethol Arfordir Cymru

Mae Arfordir Penfro yn un o'r Parciau Cenedlaethol lleiaf yn y DU, ond peidiwch â gadael i'r maint eich twyllo chi, rydych chi wrth y fynedfa i amrediad o dirweddau rhyfeddol. 
Pembrokeshire Coast National Park

The Pembrokeshire Coast is one of the smallest of the UK's National Parks, but don't let the size fool you. While the coastline may be the headline act, it's backed by a stellar supporting cast of hills, estuaries, valleys and woodlands, which means there's far more to explore than you realise.

With more than 80 beaches and coves to discover, from glorious stretches of golden sand to lonely windswept bays, there's little wonder that people are drawn to Pembrokeshire's award-winning coastline time and time again. Whether it's the sight of sea birds in spring, the explosion of wild flowers between April and July, or the magical experience of spotting seal pups under stunning September skies, Pembrokeshire Coast National Park is a place that's guaranteed to leave its imprint on both your mind and your soul.

Dilynwch Gôd Diogelwch Llwybr yr Arfordir os gwelwch yn dda

- Cadwch at y llwybr, i ffwrdd oddi wrth ymylon y clogwyni a throsgrogau
- Goruchwylwch blant ar bob adeg, yn enwedig ger ymylon y clogwyni
- Mae arwynebau cerdded yn gallu amrywio'n sylweddol yn ôl y tywydd. Gwisgwch esgidau cryfion gyda gafaell dda a chynhalwyr pigynnau bob amser
- Gwisgwch ddillad cynnes sy'n dal dŵr, neu dewch â hwy gyda chi
- Mae'n gallu bod yn beryglus cerdded at gopa clogwyni mewn gwyntoedd uchel
- Byddwch yn ofalus wrth dorri ar draws traethau i arbed amser – efallai y gallai'r llanw eich ynsu. Mae nofio'n gallu bod yn beryglus hefyd
- Peidiwch ag eistedd o dan glogwyni na'u dringo
- Cadwch eich cŵn o dan reolaeth agos
- Rheolir Llwybr yr Arfordir ar gyfer cerddwyr, nid yw'n ddio gel nac yn gyfreithlon marchogaeth na beicio ar hyd mwyafri Llwybr yr Arfordir
- Gadewch y clwydi a'r eiddo fel y cawsoch nhw
- Cofiwch nad yw signal ffôn symudol yn ddibynadwy ar yr arfordir.

Please follow the Coast Path Safety Code

- Keep to the Path, away from cliff edges and overhangs
- Always supervise children, especially near cliff edges
- Walking surfaces can vary considerably with the weather. Always wear strong footwear with a good grip and ankle support
- Wear or carry warm and waterproof clothing
- Cliff-top walking can be dangerous in high winds
- Beware of taking shortcuts across beaches – you may be cut off by the tide. Swimming can also be dangerous
- Do not sit under cliffs or climb them
- Keep dogs under close control
- The Coast Path is managed for walkers; it is not safe or lawful to cycle or ride horses along most of the Coast Path.
- Leave the gates and property as you found them.
- Remember that a mobile phone signal is not reliable on the coast.

Teithiau cerdded

Maenorbyr i Skinkle (3.2km / 2 milltir)

Taith gerdded gyffrous ar ben y clogwyn gyda golygfeydd rhagorol o Maenorbyr ac ehander diarfodd Traeth Presipe.

Bae Gorllewin Angle i Bwynt Gorllewin Angle (547 llath / 500m)

Taith fer hygrych gyda golygfeydd o'r Gaer Fictoriaid ar Ynys Thorn a goleudy Penhryn y Santes Ann.

Little Haven i Sain Ffraid (8.5km / 5.3 milltir)

Lle gwych i gerdded drwy goetir ac ar hyd copa'r clogwyni, gyda golygfeydd ar draws ehander Bae Sain Ffraid. Archwiliwch y pyllau creigiog ar draeth Mill Haven ar hyd y ffordd.

Porth Mawr i Solfach (21km / 13 milltir)

Gellir gweld lamhidydion yn y dyfroedd rhwng y tir mawr rhwng ac Ynys Dewi, felly mae'n werth stopio am seibiant ar hyd y darn hwn. Byddwch yn cyrraedd traeth eithriadol o brydferth Marloes.

Parrog Trefdraeth i'r Bont Haearn (taith cadair olwyn: 1km / 0.6 milltir)

Archwiliwch dref ganoloesol hyfryd Trefdraeth, wedi'i lleoli ar Aber Nanhŷfer.

Dinbych-y-pysgod i Saundersfoot (5.6km / 3.5 milltir)

Llwybr cerdded garw mewn coetir cysgodolyn bennaf, gyda'r opsiwn o deithio yn ôl ar fws.

Suggested walks

Manorbier to Skinkle Haven (3.2km / 2 miles)

An exhilarating cliff top walk with outstanding views of Manorbier and the secluded expanse of Presipe Beach.

West Angle Bay to West Angle Point (547 yards / 500m)

A short accessible walk with views of the Victorian fort on Thorn Island and St Ann's Head lighthouse.

Little Haven to St Brides (8.5km / 5.3 miles)

Great woodland and clifftop walking with views across the sweep of St Brides Bay. Explore the rock pools at Mill Haven beach along the way.

Whitesands to Solva (21km / 13 miles)

Porpoise can be seen in the waters between the mainland and Ramsey Island so it's worth stopping for a break along this stretch.

Newport Parrog to Iron Bridge (wheelchair walk: 1km / 0.6 miles)

Explore the lovely mediaeval town of Newport, set on the Nevern Estuary.

Tenby to Saundersfoot (5.6km / 3.5 miles)

A rugged walk, mostly in sheltered woodland, with the option of taking a bus back.
